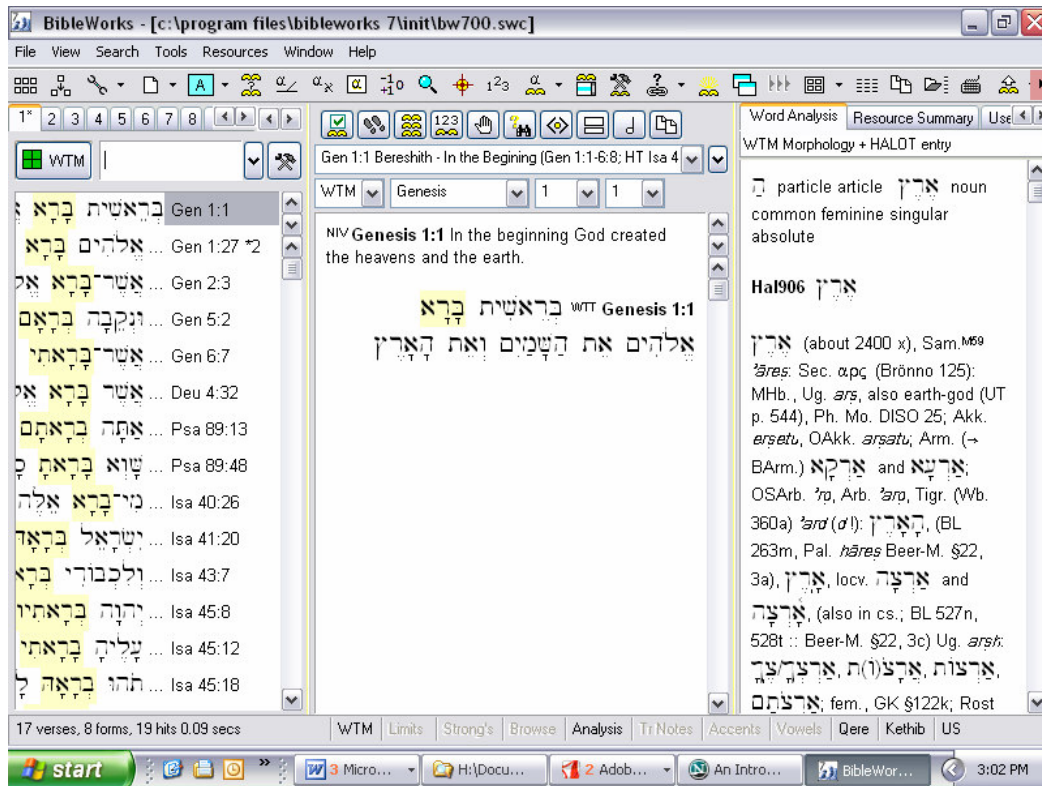

PURPOSE, GOALS, AND OBJECTIVES

Purpose: To encourage you in enjoying an abundant life to the glory of God!

Goal: To facilitate your success in acquiring

- A basic knowledge of Hebrew grammar and
- Essential skills in the use of Hebrew,
- So that you can study and teach the Hebrew Bible with greater depth and accuracy and enjoy a richer life.

Objectives:

Upon successful completion of Basic Hebrew 2 you will have:

- Mastered the basic forms and uses of Hebrew suffixes, infinitives, participles, volitives, vav-relative, piel, hiphil, niphal, perfect, and imperfect.
- Mastered a basic vocabulary of 200 Hebrew words.
- Applied your computer skills to learn the theological significance of ten key Hebrew words or phrases.
- Grown in your enjoyment of the Hebrew language.
- Grown in your commitment to use your Hebrew knowledge and skills in a life-long study of the Hebrew Bible.

REQUIREMENTS

Quizzes

- There are 10 quizzes.
- Each quiz will be open from 4:00 p.m. on Thursday (starting May 31) until 4:00 p.m. on the following Thursday.
 - You may take your quiz any time during this period.
 - Once a quiz is closed, you have missed the opportunity to take it.
 - Do not wait until the last minute.
- The quizzes are worth 10 points each or 100 total points.

- Late work is not accepted.

Workbook

- There are 10 Workbook assignments.
- The Workbook assignments are worth 15 points each or 150 total points.
- The Workbook assignments are to be e-mailed to your instructor by 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, with the first one due by June 7.

Posts
