### ASSIGNMENTS

- 1. Reading report (30 %):** Students will turn in a reading report stating the percentage of the assigned readings that they have completed.

- 3. Response paper (40 %):** Students will write a short essay (5 pages, double-spaced) that addresses the question: “What are the primary means that God has appointed for gospel sanctification?” The paper should interact with lectures, class discussions, and assigned reading.
