### **1. Applying**

You can take Apologetics for credit or as an auditor. If you wish to enroll for credit you must first apply to RTS by submitting the following materials:

- (1) Special Student Application (download it here:

- (2) official undergraduate transcripts
- (3) \$25 application fee

The application must be received by ~~April 1~~ **May 1 [extended due date]** and should be sent to the address at the bottom of this page.

Both credit students and audit students must pre-register online. Please pre-register as soon as possible to make sure you have a space reserved and so that we can be in touch with any updates. Here's how to pre-register:

## 2. Pre-registering

- ✓ Screen 1. Enter your Student Number (your Social Security Number, including dashes) and your last name. Click “Go.”
- ✓ Screen 2. Completely fill in all blanks. Click “Update.”
- ✓ Screen 3. Click “Register for New Courses.”
- ✓ Screen 4. Click “Next Step - Location.” (“Master’s Degree Courses” is the default)
- ✓ Screen 5. Use the pull-down menu to select “Washington/Baltimore.” Click “Next – Select Term, and Credit or Audit.”
- ✓ Screen 6. Use the pull-down menu to select “Spring 2006”. Choose either “credit” or “audit.” Click “Proceed to Course Selection.”
- ✓ Screen 7. Scroll down until you see Apologetics XX. Click the blue hyperlink to make your selection.
- ✓ Screen 8. Make sure the information on this screen corresponds with the course you have chosen. If it is correct, scroll to the bottom of the screen and click “add to course list.”
- ✓ Screen 9. Your selection should be indicated on the screen. If it is correct, scroll down and click “Finish course selection.”
- ✓ Screen 10. You’re done!
