PSALM 23 PROJECT

- You will write a paper on Psalm 23.
- Your research will follow the steps laid out in chapter 5 of *Interpreting the Psalms*.
- Your paper will follow the model set out in chapter 6 of *Interpreting the Psalms*.
- You may write up to 15 double-spaced pages with 1 inch margins on all sides and using a 12 point font.
- Your paper is due on Friday, October 8, at the beginning of class.
- We will have an in-class discussion of Psalm 23 on Friday, October 8.

ASSESSMENTS

- Psalm 23 Project:
 - 50 points.
 - Grading criteria: content, clarity, conformity (to the model set out in chapter 6 of *Interpreting the Psalms*).
- Final exam:
 - 50 points.
 - Coverage: lectures on Proverbs, Job, and Ecclesiastes and reading on Proverbs, Job, and Ecclesiastes in *Exploring the Old Testament: A Guide to the Psalms and Wisdom Literature*.
